



WILDERNESS HUNT PERSONAL ITEMS LIST

- ___ **Hunting License:** *Please also bring a picture I.D. with you.*
- ___ **Conservation Stamp:** Can be purchased locally you arrive.
- ___ **Rifle:** 30.06, .270, .280, .300 Winchester Magnum, and 7mm Magnum. We don't like automatics. Practice Shooting as much as possible before your hunt. If possible, site in 200-300 yards; be comfortable to 500 yards.
- ___ **Ammo:** Three boxes are plenty. If you think you need more, spend more time at the shooting range.
- ___ **Sleeping Bag & Pillow:** We like the Halo-fill type rated to at least -20. Down is good. We furnish cots and foam pads.
 - *Not necessary for the Ranch hunts.**
- ___ **Field Glasses:** 7x35 or more powerful.
- ___ **Hunting Knife**
- ___ **Hat:** For protection and warmth.
- ___ **Alarm Clock**
- ___ **Small Flashlight or Head lamp**
- ___ **Camera**
- ___ **Shirts:** Two wool and two cotton.
- ___ **Socks:** Four heavy and four light.
- ___ **Toilet Kit:** Include a chapstick and sun screen.
- ___ **Handkerchief**
- ___ **Hunting Coat and Rain gear:** gortex is best
- ___ **Sun Glasses**
- ___ **Zippo Lighter**
- ___ **Liquor:** We don't do any heavy drinking, but an evening drink goes well after a hard day hunting.
- ___ **Flash Orange**
- ___ **Boots:** Waterproof hunting boots
- ___ **Gloves:** One leather pair and a couple pair of cotton work gloves.
- ___ **Moccasins:** Or comfortable shoes to wear around camp.
- ___ **Pants:** Blue jeans or wool pants.
- ___ **Long Underware:** Two pairs.
- ___ **Plastic Bag:** Handy to have for dirty clothes.
- ___ **Duffle Bag:** Army style or side zipper type are best. *We prefer to see two 35# duffle bags rather than one large bag.*
- ___ **Towel and Wash Cloth**
- ___ **Pen:** to sign game tag in the field
- ___ **Water Bottle**
- ___ **Game Bags**
- ___ **Bear Spray:** *This will have to be bought in Cody if you are flying as it is a forbidden substance on a plane.*
- ___ **Ibuprofen, Tylenol or Aleve**
